2. No stock to leave designated compound during show.
3. **All passports and pedigrees must accompany ALL animals; handing in on arrival, along with Proof of Pre-movement testing.**
All animals not accompanied by these 3 documents will leave the show.
4. All competitors to wear breed show uniform.
5. No restriction of number of calves per class per exhibitor.
6. A "sin bin" will be in operation during judging for any misbehaving calves for the benefit safety to yourselves and fellow competitors.
7. There will be no straw/fodder supplied, please bring your own.
8. Handlers may only compete in one breed section.
9. The judge's decision is final.
10. All breeds to be shown under their Society Rules.
11. **Non Pedigree animals are not eligible for their respective breed championships – The highest placed pedigree animal will go forward for that breed**

IMPORTANT NOTES TO QUALIFYERS

All winners from classes 1-11 may compete at the National Calf Show (a 2nd prize calf can only automatically qualify if it is Reserve Champion in the breed)
When a calf qualifies from a non HYB handled entrant, please note that it is that exhibitor's responsibility to escort their own animal to the show bearing the full cost of travel & accommodation including responsibility of finding a suitable handler from the area prior to the event, otherwise, the runner up will be offered that place.

Any financial assistance will be allocated to any HYB member calf.

Any animal attending the National MUST display their exhibit as part of the area on the designated team stand.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Due to new regulations by Defra Animal Health ALL animals attending this year's Southwest All Breeds calf show must have a valid pre-movement test.

Evidence must be provided before animals will be allowed into the show.

The show committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any animals without the correct paperwork
